

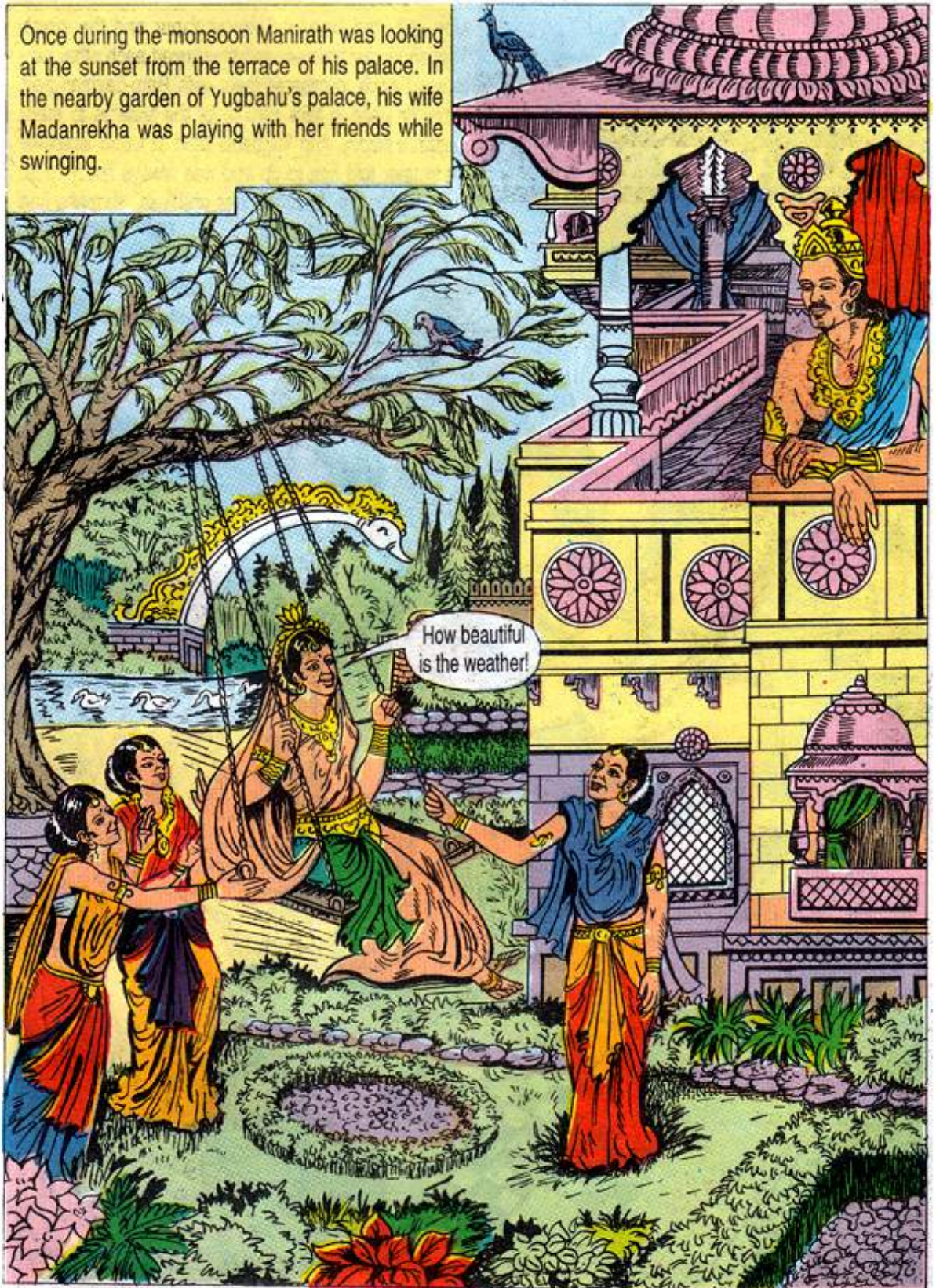
MAHASATI MADANREKHA

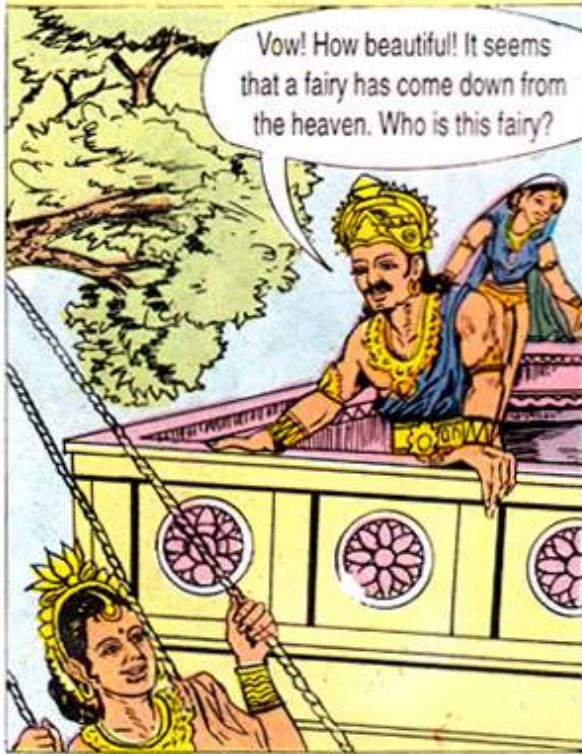
Brother! This game will never end... It's time for supper. Let us go.

Suddenly Manirath saw Madanrekha.

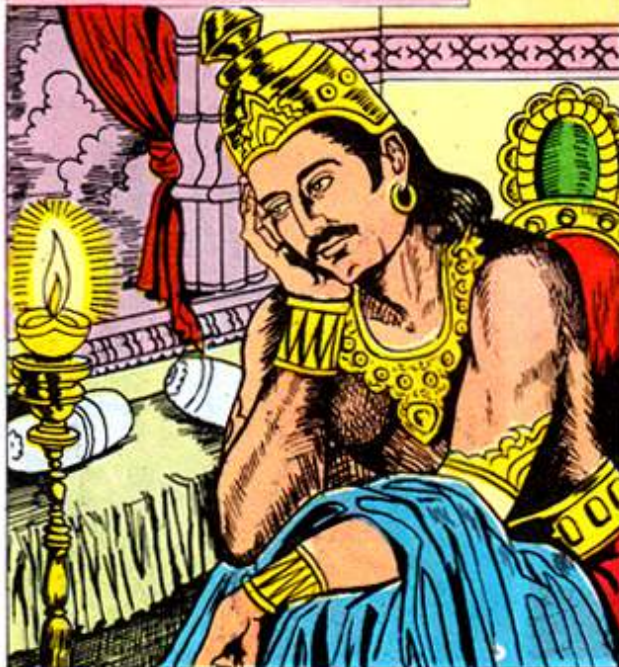


A maid, standing near Manirath said-
